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# Exploring Early Childhood Curriculum

## Applications Now Open

This free online course is for educators wanting to learn how to use *Flight: Alberta's Early Learning and Care Framework* to guide their daily practices.

### Who is the course for?

This non-credit online course is intended for ELCC educators working in licensed and approved programs. January 2021, a course for OSC educators working with school-age children will be offered.

The online course is available in French or English.

### What does the course involve?

The course is 22-weeks and includes virtual classes, online discussions and reflective writing assignments. Course participants commit about 4-6 hours per week to course learning activities and upon successful course completion will receive a certificate.

### Why would educators take the course?

The course helps educators increase their reflective practice, understand the importance of responsive early childhood practice, and make the important work they do visible and valuable.
